Conference attendees must be registered for the Michigan HOSA state leadership conference by their HOSA advisor using the HOSA Conference Management System, the same way they registered for regionals. When registering, you will need to include students' t-shirt size. Advisors may select a ladies' open cardigan or a unisex microfleece full-zip (pictured below). The cardigan and full-zip are for advisors only.



NOTE: The only people that need to register for the conference and pay the \$80 registration fee are students, advisors and anyone who would like the conference materials provided (conference program, t-shirt or advisor pullover, name badge, admittance and an assigned seat at the general sessions, including award ceremonies). If a guest/family member/chaperone plans to attend but does NOT want/need these items (including a seat at the ceremonies), they do NOT need to register and pay for the conference.

Digital Upload Information

Students/teams are required to upload materials for their competitive event to be prejudged for SLC by March 22, 2025 by 11:59 PM. Even though they submitted materials for regionals, they MUST re-submit materials for SLC to be prejudged. Competitors can make any necessary changes to their document(s) before resubmitting. Failure to upload materials by the deadline will result in a score of zero for that portion of the event. Students/teams can still compete in round two at the conference, but they will not have a score for round one of the event.

IEPS and Accommodations

For events that require an IEP (Interviewing Skills, Personal Care, Life Support Skills, Speaking Skills), advisors do NOT need to re-submit the IEP form UNLESS something has changed/needs to be updated. Michigan HOSA will use the form that was submitted for regionals. Advisors with students that do not have an IEP but are requesting an accommodation need to have this form filled out by March 22, 2025. If an accommodation request was already made for regionals, the form does not need to be resubmitted. These forms must be filled out by the advisors/school personnel only, not students. ATC Testing & Recognition Events

NEW THIS YEAR: Students who would like to take an ATC knowledge test(s) AND/OR participate in a Recognition Event need to register in the ATC Tests & Recognitions **Events- 2025 SLC** event in the CMS. You will not be able to register for these in the main 2025 Michigan HOSA State Leadership Conference in the CMS. ATC tests are not considered HOSA competitive events. They are part of the HOSA Recognition Events category. Therefore, they will be taken ONLINE ONLY, open note/book, on March 29, 2025. These tests can be taken anytime between 8:00 AM- 8:00 PM on March 29. They do not need to be taken at school or with a proctor. Participants will receive a certificate of completion and results will be posted online. The top 5 competitor names in each event will be recognized in the 2025 Michigan HOSA State Leadership Conference program. Students will NOT be recognized on-stage at the state leadership conference in April. ATC tests are FREE and any HOSA member can take them (whether they have qualified for SLC or not). Students can take as many tests as they want. If a student is only taking an ATC test(s) and/or doing a recognition event, they only need to register for these in the ATC Tests & Recognition Events event in the CMS. If students are participating in an ATC test/Recognition Event AND a HOSA competitive event, students must be registered for BOTH the "ATC Tests & Recognition Events- 2025 SLC" AND the "2025 Michigan HOSA State Leadership Conference" in CMS.
