What is it?

The Gift of Life HOSA Challenge is a 3-week service project for Michigan HOSA chapters that saves lives. During the HOSA Challenge, students recruit their peers and community members to join the Michigan Organ Donor Registry while completing activities to educate them about the importance of organ and tissue donation.

How does it work?

- 1. Sign your chapter up to participate at golm.org/hosa.
- Register to attend the HOSA Challenge webinar on October 1 at 7 p.m. at golm.org/HOSAChallengeWebinar.

The webinar will cover donation basics and how to sign people up on the Michigan Organ Donor Registry.

- Keep an eye out for your free Challenge Toolkit with your Donor Registry link, materials and giveaways. Toolkits will be mailed the week of September 30.
- 4. From October 7 to October 25, complete activities listed on the scorecard and log them at golm.org/hosa to earn points.
- 5. Redeem your points for Visa gift cards.
